Horne has been located and reunited with her family.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is requesting assistance from the public in locating a missing endangered adult female.

Mary Horne was last seen on August 2nd at approximately 9:45 AM at her home in the 1400 block of Northwest 8th Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Family members went to check on Horne who was sitting on the front porch of the residence, and discovered that she was gone. Law enforcement officials conducted a canvass of the area and have been unable to locate her.

Horne is described as a 66 year old, B/F, 5'8", approximately 320 lbs., with a heavy build. She was last seen wearing a grey t-shirt and dark sweat pants.

Horne suffers from diabetes and high blood pressure, and is considered endangered.
