

# Public Notice

The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (Byrne/JAG) Program is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions. Byrne/JAG local allocation funds may be used to support a range of program areas including law enforcement, prosecution and court programs, prevention and education programs, and crime victim and witness programs.

The City of Fort Lauderdale Police Department will be receiving \$90,751 in funding under the FY 2018 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant program. The Fort Lauderdale Police Department proposes to use our FY 2018 Byrne/JAG allocation to improve investigative and public safety capabilities. The proposed distribution of these funds is listed below. The City of Pompano Beach will serve as the lead fiscal agent for all cities in Broward County that have been allocated FY18 Byrne/JAG local grant awards.
